Youville House is located on a seven-acre campus, which includes Youville Hospital, offering in-patient medical care and rehabilitation services to adults. The hospital was founded in 1895 by the Sisters of Charity of Montreal, also known as the “Grey Nuns,” and was subsequently named for their foundress, Saint Marguerite d’Youville.

The campus also houses an outpatient medical center offering primary and specialty care for older adults. Residents of Youville House may choose to have their primary care right on campus.

Youville House is managed by Covenant Health Systems, a New England-wide Catholic, not-for-profit, health care organization.

At Youville House people of all faiths, races and cultures are warmly welcomed, respected, and celebrated.

Security and Peace of Mind

At Youville House we understand the challenges families and residents face as they transition to assisted living. Our staff consists of a team of highly qualified individuals dedicated to offering support and encouragement to all residents. Our goal is to help each resident experience independence, dignity, privacy, and enthusiasm for each new day.

Wellness nurses are available to our residents seven days a week and resident care assistants are on the premises 24 hours a day. Each apartment is equipped with two emergency call systems, and residents are provided with pendants to notify staff if help is needed.

A Personalized Approach to Each Resident's Needs

Our wellness staff assists each resident with up to one hour of personal care assistance a day which may include help with dressing, grooming, bathing, escorts to activities and the dining room and medication reminders. Three healthy and delicious meals are prepared daily by a staff of professional chefs and served in our main dining room. Housekeeping, including linen service, is provided weekly.
